Dear Families,

Welcome back after the Christmas break – I hope you had a lovely holiday and I wish you all the very best for 2024.

School Attendance

As you may have seen in the media, school attendance is an issue that has come into great focus recently. Following the pandemic, national school attendance has fallen significantly and the number of persistent absentees (children whose attendance is below 90%) has doubled. Although 90% sounds like quite a high figure, it equates to, on average, half a day off every week. Can I please ask that when children are well enough to do so that they come into school, even if it is for the last day or two of the week, and that wherever possible, holidays and appointments are made outside of school time. If you are unsure whether you should send your child to school or not, please see the guidance from the NHS <u>HERE</u>. If you would like support or advice around your child's attendance, every school in Newcastle has been allocated an Attendance Officer who will be able to provide it. Thank you for your continued support with this.

Nativity Costume Donations

I know that thinking about Christmas is the last thing on people's minds right now, but we would like to ask families if they have any Nativity costumes that they would like to donate to school. In future, rather than asking parents to provide children with costumes at what we recognise is a very busy time of the year, we have decided to supply them ourselves. So, any donations of costumes that you may have in the house from this, or previous years, would be very gratefully accepted.

Water Bottles/Pencil Cases

Many children have brought some very expensive pencil cases and water bottles into school following the Christmas holidays. Bringing these items into school unfortunately brings with it the risk of damage or loss, so to avoid upset, it may be wise to keep them in the safety of your home.

PTA Fundraising

You may have seen the posters around school already, but if you haven't, I would like to inform you that thanks to our wonderful PTA and to your amazing support and generosity, we have raised over £3500 since September! This money has gone towards developing a sensory room, redesigning our IT suite into a much more practical working area, and buying a mobile laptop charging unit so that children from Reception to Year 6 can access the technology in their classrooms. We are looking at what we can use future fundraising for and are in the process of exploring the possibility of developing an area in our grounds into a Forest School which is a space where children can learn personal, social and technical skills outdoors - I will keep you updated with any progress made.
