## **Stay Safe On Your Bike!**

As you may know, we provide Bikeability (cycle) training but we have noticed that many pupils do not wear a cycle helmet. Whilst there is not a legal requirement to wear a helmet, many bicycles are purchased over the festive season. We thought that if people are purchasing a helmet, this should be the correct size, standard and that it fits correctly.

If you are buying a cycle helmet this festive season, ensure it is has a minimum standard of BS EN1078, you may also find a helmet with an American based standard (Snell Foundation B90) which is a substantially stronger standard.
