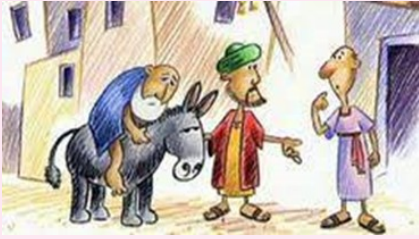


I know what to do if I see anyone being hurt.
